Naran Valley, also called Naran Kaghan, is a popular tourist destination. The medium-sized town of Naran is located in Pakistan's Khyber Pakhtun Khwa province in the upper Kaghan Valley. This is one of Pakistan's most picturesque regions in the north, perched ²⁵⁰⁰ metres above sea level.

Because of its beautiful weather throughout the busiest time of year, hundreds of tourists go to Naran Kaghan every year to explore the valley. Moreover, Babusar Pass serves as the entryway to Gilgit Hunza in the summer.

- Overnight stay in Naran.



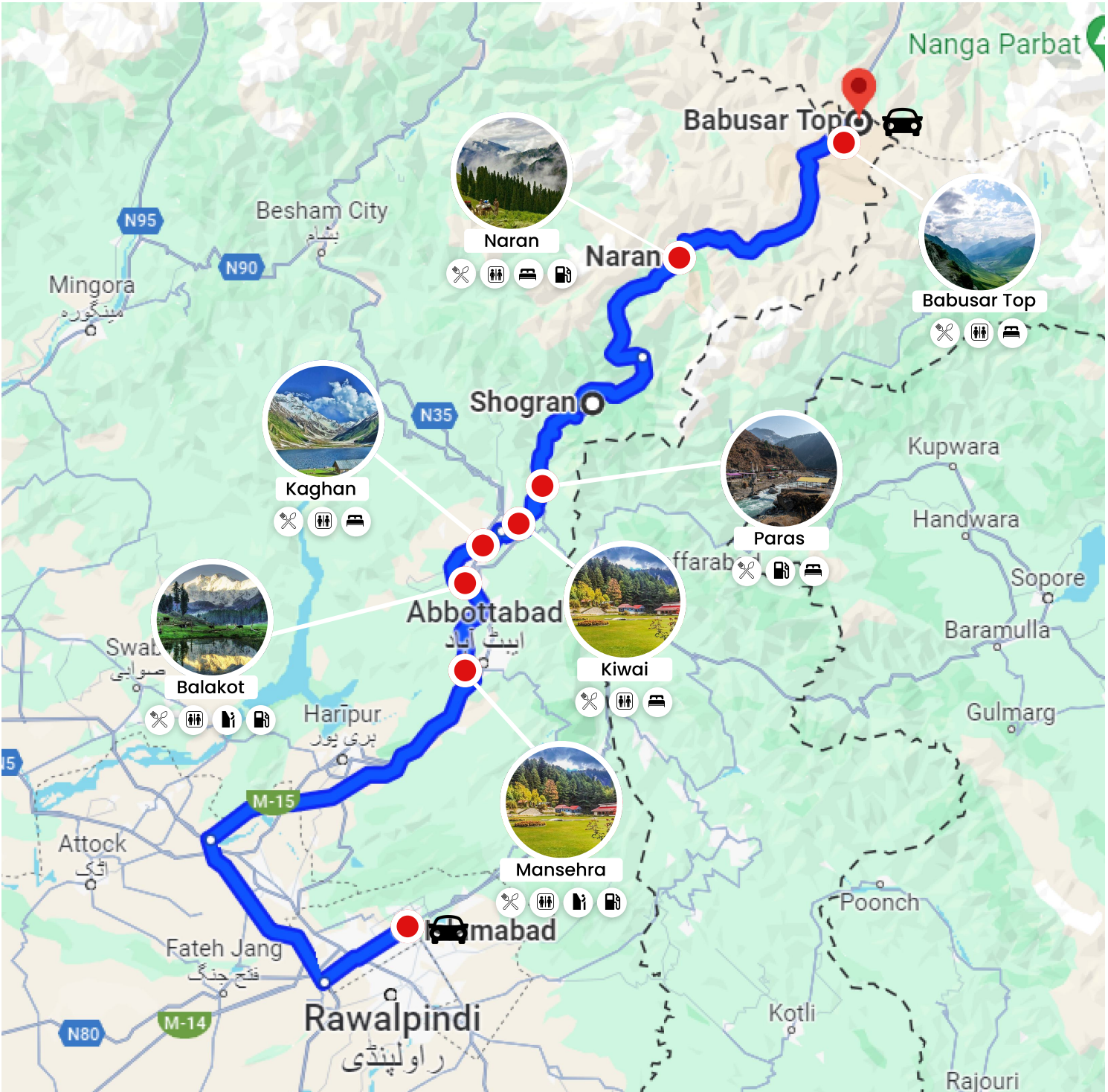
Day 5

PLACES TO VISIT

River Kunhar:

The river, also known as River Kunhar, is 177 kilometres (110 mi) long and mostly found in the northern Pakistani province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. About 48 kilometres from the Naran Valley is Lulusar Lake, one of the river's primary sources. The river is fed by the waters of Saiful Muluk Lake and the glaciers of Malka Parbat and Makra Peak. The Kunhar enters the Jhelum River after passing through the whole Kaghan Valley, including Jalkhand, Naran, Kaghan, Jared, Paras, and Balakot.



Jheel Saif-Ul-Malook:

Saiful Mulook is a mountain lake in the Mansehra district of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, located at the northern end of the Kaghan Valley. Located 3,224 metres above sea level, this lake is one of Pakistan's highest lakes. It is a well-liked tourist destination with amazing surrounding's views. If you are organising a vacation to the Kaghan Valley, you must make sure that your itinerary includes a visit to Jheel Saif Ul Malook.



Babusar Top:

Babusar Pass, also known as Babusar Top, stands at an elevation of 13,691 feet, making it the highest point in the Kaghan Valley. This mountain pass is located in the Kaghan Valley, connecting the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. The breathtaking view of massive mountains, lightly dusted with snow, captivates anyone who beholds it. Babusar pass is the main visiting place of your tour to Naran..



Lulusar Lake:

A lake and a collection of mountain peaks in the Kaghan Valley are known as Lulusar or Lulusar. At 3,410 metres (11,190 feet), Lulusar Lake serves as the main headwaters for the Kunhar River. Over all, if you really want to see Kaghan Valley beauty, Lulusar lake is worth it and you really cant miss that gem. The lake itself has breathtaking views of a snow-capped lake surface.



Lala Zar Meadows:

Northern areas of Pakistan are full of natural beauty, but Lalazar is one of the most beautiful place. Located near Naran.Lalazar is a green meadow situated at the height of an elevation of 3,123 metres (10,246 ft) above the sea level, located in upper Kaghan Valley in Mansehra District of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province of Pakistan, The route to Lalazar is on the Mansehra-Naran-Babusar-Chillas highway toward Babusar, the drive is mesmerizing in itself as the marvelous River Kunhar is flowing along the route on the left and the mountain covered with Alpine Forest is on the right. The road till Battakundi is paved and smooth but after Battakundi, the road started climbing up on the mountain road.



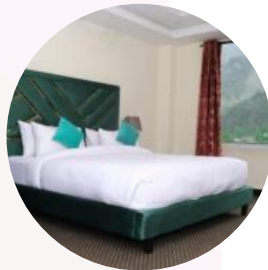
Sarai Hotel:
