4 Departure for Keran

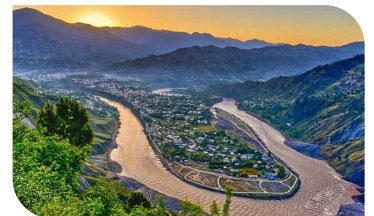
- Enjoy fresh morning and Sightseeing in Arrang kel.

Sharda:

Taobat:

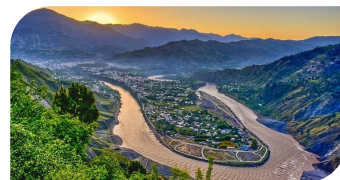
Kutton Waterfall:

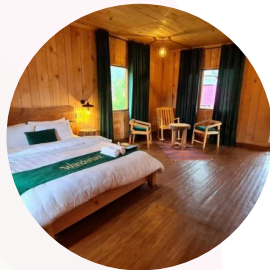
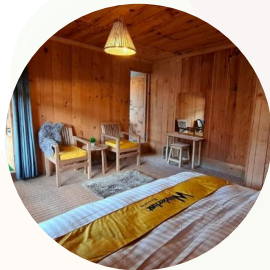
Vadi Hotel:

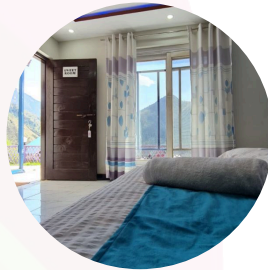
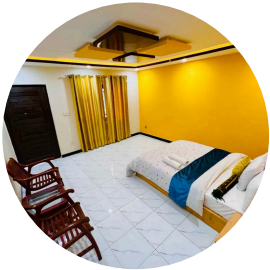
Green Village

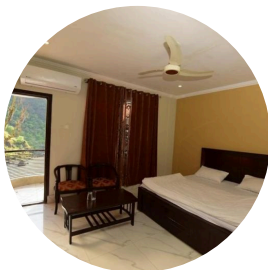
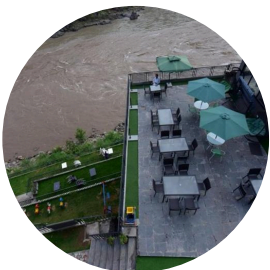
Wander Hill Cottages:

Roghan Josh:

Roghan Josh is a rich and flavorful lamb dish that originated in Kashmir. The lamb is cooked in a tomato-based gravy with a blend of aromatic spices, including cardamom, cloves, cinnamon, and cumin. This dish is best served with naan or rice.



Chouck Waangan:

Chouck Waangan is a traditional dish of Azad Kashmir made from fried eggplants that are cooked in spicy tomato-based gravy. This dish is usually served with steamed rice or naan.



Hareesa:

"Hareesa" is believed to have been derived from the Arabic word "Harasa," which means to pound or mash. This is appropriate, considering that Hareesa is a dish primarily composed of wheat and meat, cooked to a soft, creamy consistency by pounding.



Nadur Yakhni:

Nadur Yakhni is a vegetarian dish made from lotus stems that are cooked in a creamy yogurt gravy with a blend of aromatic spices. This dish is usually served with steamed rice or naan.



Shab Deg:

Shab Deg is a slow-cooked lamb and vegetable stew that is usually served during the winter months in Azad Kashmir. The lamb is cooked with a variety of vegetables, including turnips, carrots, and potatoes, with a blend of aromatic spices. This dish is best enjoyed with steamed rice or naan.



Gushtaba:

Gushtaba is another delicious Kashmiri speciality. A concoction of minced mutton rolled into balls and cooked in curd and spices, the meat used has additional fat added to it, and is cooked over a period of several hours to bring out the richness and get the consistency just right.
